


**Parking**

*The Community Based Clinic is designed to bring Primary Care and Optometry Services to eligible veterans living in Casa Grande and the Pinal county areas. The clinic is open 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday.*

## **Staff**

Your Casa Grande healthcare team includes the services of Nurse Practitioners, Licensed Practical Nurses and a Patient Services Assistant. They are linked to Physicians at the Tucson SAVAHCS using “Telemedicine,” a state of the art telecommunications system that allows the team members and their patients instant access to the resources of the larger medical center.

## **Laboratory Services**

Point-of-care lab testing capabilities are available on site. More complex laboratory tests are sent to the Tucson SAVAHCS. Daily shuttle service connects the two facilities, allowing rapid reporting on most diagnostic tests.

## **Speciality Care**

Subspecialty care and inpatient care for enrolled patients is provided at the Tucson SAVAHCS.

## **Services and Scope of Care**

## **Medications**

An initial supply, if needed, will be issued during patient appointments. Medications beyond the initial supply will be provided through the VA's pharmacy mail-out program.
