“SAVAHCS Primary Care Services now available in Pima and Santa Cruz Counties, Arizona.”

The Community Based Clinic is designed to bring Primary Care Services to eligible veterans living in Southern Pima and Santa Cruz county areas. The clinic is open 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday.

Staff

Your Green Valley healthcare team includes the services of Nurse Practitioners, Registered Nurses, Licensed Practical Nurses and a Patient Services Assistant. They are linked to Physicians at the Tucson SAVAHCS giving them access to the resources of the larger medical center.

Laboratory Services

Point-of-care lab testing capabilities are available on site. More complex laboratory tests are sent to the Tucson SAVAHCS. Daily shuttle service connects the two facilities, allowing rapid reporting on most diagnostic tests.

Speciality Care

Subspecialty care and inpatient care for enrolled patients is provided at the Tucson SAVAHCS.

- Health screening

Medications

An initial supply, if needed, will be issued during patient appointments. Medications beyond the initial supply will be provided through the VA's pharmacy mail-out program.
