# *"Primary Care Services now available in Southeastern Arizona."*

*The Community Based Clinic is designed to bring Primary Care Services to eligible veterans living in Southeastern Arizona. The clinic is open 7 AM - 3 PM, Monday through Friday.*

## **Staff**

Nurse Practitioners, a Registered Nurse, a Licensed Practical Nurse and a Patient Services Assistant are your health care team members. They are linked to physicians at the SAVAHCS Tucson campus using "Telemedicine," a state of the art satellite system that allows them instant access to the resources of the larger medical center.

## **Laboratory Services**

Urgent laboratory services are available through the RW Bliss Army laboratory. Routine laboratory tests are sent to the SAVAHCS main campus in Tucson. A daily shuttle service connects the two facilities, allowing 24 hour turn around time on most diagnostic tests.

## **Speciality Care**

Subspecialty care and inpatient care for enrolled patients is provided for at the SAVAHCS Tucson facility.

## **Services and Scope of Care**

- Health screening
- Health promotion
- Health maintenance
- Education
- Management of acute and chronic diseases
- Women's Health
- Routine/urgent care procedures, such as:
  - Dermatologic procedures,
  - Gynecological exams
  - Skin tests
  - Dressing changes
  - Immunizations

## **Emergency Care**

Emergency services are not available at the Sierra Vista Primary Care Clinic. Emergency care will be handled through 911 or by the Life Support Unit at the SAVAHCS: (520)792-1450.

## **Medications**

An initial supply will be issued during patient appointments. Medications beyond the initial supply will be provided through the VA's pharmacy mail-out program.
