II. Agenda

- A. A Year in Review:
 - 1. There were 35 capital grants funded in 2009.
 - 2. 5 projects are now fully operational.
 - 3. 12-15 projects are projected to be operational by the end of FY 2010.
 - 4. Remaining projects under development are projected to be operational by August 2011.
 - 5. The average number of workdays between final inspections and project activation date is: 11 workdays.
 - 6. Agency's that choose to admit Veterans prior to receiving the official Per Diem Action Sheet from the GPD Program Office do so at their own risk as there is no guarantee of back payment.
