## Memorandum of Understanding

The following constitutes an agreement between the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), and the American Federation of Government Employees, (AFL-CIO) National Veterans Affairs Council #53 (NVAC) on the Office of Diversity and Inclusion (ODI) and VA Learning University (VALU) MyCareer@VA Pilot.

- 1. The national parties agree to agree the purpose of this pilot program is to inform, connect and train employees, supervisors, and mentors on career development activities; tools and resources to assist in career progression barriers; and create a culture of career development. diversity and inclusion. The implementation of this pilot does not change or alter bargaining unit employees' rights under Article 37 – Training and Career Development, VA/AFGE Master Agreement.
- 2. Wage Grade and General Schedule bargaining unit employees in grades 1 through 9 from Boston Healthcare System, Baltimore VA Medical Center and the Board of Veterans Appeals, may participate in the MyCareer@VA Pilot program.
- 3. Training related to this pilot program will be on duty time, at various hours to allow all participates to receive the training.
- 4. NVAC and AFGE Locals shall receive a copy of the pilot results once completed.
- 5. NVAC reserves its right to address matters related to this pilot as they occur.

6. Upon their receipt, the appropriate management official shall provide a copy of this MOU to the Local Union President(s).
