Memorandum of Understanding

The following constitutes an agreement between the Department of Veterans Affairs, (VA) and the American Federation of Government Employees, (AFL-CIO), National Veterans Affairs Council #53, on VA Thin Client Use and Replacement of Existing Thin Client End Point Devices.

- 1. The national parties have agreed to a phase-in replacement of Thin Clients with PC to remove obsolete Thin Clients from the VA network. OIT will begin the phase-in replacement of thin clients as a top priority by the following schedule:
 - First priority Thin Clients older than 5 years will be replaced in less than 120 days from receipt of a replacement PC
 - Second priority: Thin Clients 3 -5 years old will be replaced within 180 days from receipt of replacement PC.
 - Last priority: All remaining Thin Clients must be replaced by the end of fiscal year 2014.
- 2. Bargaining unit employees will not experience a loss of efficiency due to the replacement of Thin Clients Devices.
- 3. All current applications on Thin Clients devices shall be programed to work on the PC and working properly prior to the replacement.
- 4. Training related to the new replacement PC shall be on duty time.

5. Upon their receipt, the appropriate management official shall provide the Local Union President with a copy of this MOU.
