Memorandum of Understanding

The following constitutes an agreement between the Department of Veterans Affairs, Veterans Health Administration, and the American Federation of Government Employees, (AFL-CIO) National Veterans Affairs Council #53 concerning the Office of Community Care Payment Operations (OCC) and Management (POM) Addendum on POM Transformation and Centralization 2022.

- 1. This OCC POM centralization changes the National Payment Centers from thirteen (13) to ten (10) locations. The sites decentralized include Albany, NY, Birmingham, AL, and Boston MA. Currente AFGE POM bargaining unit employees from the three sites being decentralized sties, will remaine in the AFGE bargaining unit.e
- 2.e POM bargaining unit employees from the affected sites may be offered a position at VHA facilitiese within a VISN that may include Clinical Contact Centers, Beneficiary Travel, and Appointmente Scheduling or other agreed to positions. In any case AFGE bargaining unit employees will not be required to accept a position lower than their current grade. Those bargaining unit employees placede by the Department in lower graded positions will retain their grade as allowed by rule, law ore regulation and will be entitled to all pay increases in their current position unlesse the employee voluntarily requests a reassignment to another position.e
- 3.eAffected bargaining unit employees from the named sites above, will not lose any scheduled ande approved Annual Leave in effect strictly due to this decentralization upon the signing of this MOU.e
- 4. Any training required shall be on duty time and at various times to allow the affected bargaininge unit employees to attend.e
- 5. Management Directed Reassignments (MDR) are the preferred method in POM Transformation ande Centralization 2022: however, AFGE bargaining unit employees may elect to compete for promotionse or submit for self-identified voluntary reassignments at any time during this process. While thesee reassignments may start upon the signing of this MOU; it can be expected to conclude within six (6)e months.e
- 6.e NVAC reserves its right to address matter related to the updated POM Centralization ase they occur.e

7.eUpon their receipt the appropriate management official shall provide a copy of this MOU toe the AFGE Locals Presidents affected by this update POM Centralization.e
