Memorandum of Understanding

The following constitutes an agreement between the Department of Veterans Affairs, Veterans Health Administration (VHA) and the American Federation of Government Employees, (AFL-CIO), National Veteran Affairs Council #53, on VHA Deployment of Models for Medication Assisted Treatment Training for Opioid Use Disorder.

- 1. Each VISN will have pilot teams that will use one of these two Model:
 - Standard Medical Management Model- Qualified Provider (Physician, Nurse Practitioner or Physician Assistant; Team Nurse (RN) and Therapist (e.g. Psychologist, Social Worker, Addiction Therapist)
 - Collaborative Care Model Qualified Provider (Physician, Nurse Practitioner or Physician Assistant; Team Nurse (RN); Care Coordinator (e.g. Team Nurse, Clinical Pharmacist; Social Worker; Therapist or another trained clinician) and Clinical Pharmacist.
- Any training relate to the above subject shall be on duty time for bargaining unit employees, at various time to allow all employees to attend.
- 3. Bargaining unit employees may request to take the training more than once.
- AFGE Locals may request to be briefed on the local implementation at their facility and/or duty location.
- Upon their receipt, the appropriate management official shall provide a copy of this MOU to the AFGE Local President.
