Memorandum of Understanding

The following constitutes an agreement between the Department of Veterans Affairs, Veterans Health Administration, (VHA) and the American Federation of Government Employees, (AFL-CIO), National Veterans Affairs Council #53, on VHA Directive 1603 Training and Certifications of VHA Examiners Completing VA Compensation and Pension (C&P) Disability Examinations.

- 1. Training and General C&P Certification shall be done on duty time and at various times to allow all affected bargaining unit employees to attend the mandatory training and specialized examinations training listed below.
- Certification to perform general Compensation and Pension exams requires the completion of five mandatory training courses: DMA General Certification Overview (VA 5496); DMA Military Sexual Trauma (MST) and the Disability Examination Process (VA 23409); DMA Medical Opinions (VA 24627); DMA Aggravation Opinions (VA 24471) and DMA Gulf War General Medical Exam (VA 24549).
- 3. The Specialized Examination requirements are: Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder examinations (VA 5497), Initial Mental Health Disorders examination (VA 5522), Musculoskeletal examinations (VA 5516) and Traumatic Brain Injury examinations (VA 9238).
- 4. AFGE Locals may elect to bargain on the local procedures regarding the release of bargaining unit employees for completion of mandated and required training of VHA Directive 1603.
- 5. Upon their receipt, the appropriate management officials shall provide a copy of this MOU to the AFGE Local President.
