MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

- The following agreement is between the department of Veterans Affairs (VA), Veterans
 Health Administration (VHA) and the National Federation of Federal Employees
 (NFFE), VA Council of Consolidated Locals (Union) in regard to Mental Health
 Scheduler Training.
- Consistent with Article 3 and Article 36 of the VA/NFEE Master Agreement, bargaining
 unit employees have the right to in-service training necessary to insure satisfactory job
 performance and the right to have training scheduled on duty time.
- If Mental Health Scheduler Training implementation results in a negotiable change in conditions of employment, the Department will meet its bargaining obligation consistent with Article 8 of the VA/NFFE National Collective Bargaining Agreement and the Statute.
- 4. If the Employer establishes a chartered process action, performance improvement team, or like task force or workgroup dealing with conditions of employment or personnel practices affecting bargaining unit employees, the Union will be given the opportunity to designate at least one representative to that group. Official time for representatives not already on official time is independent of the time negotiated in the master agreement.
- NFFE National midterm bargaining team reserves the right to address issues related to Mental Health Scheduler Training as they occur that have not been covered by this MOU.
