Virtual Lifetime Electronic Record

On March 19-22, 2012, a four-day collaborative meeting will be held in Phoenix, AZ, by Virtual Lifetime Electronic Record Enterprise Program Management Office (VLER EPMO), Office of Health Systems (HS), and Office of Business Process Integration (OBPI). The meeting will center on developments to the Veterans Authorization Preferences (VAP) Project and VAP Interface Improvement (VAPii), projects within the VLER Core Services portfolio. The purpose is to reprioritize the current pool of business requirements for VAP and collect and document new business requirements for the long-term vision of the VAPii project. VAP is the intra-VA system that acts as a broker allowing information exchange. VAPii is our external-facing application where Veterans can complete all required releases of information within a centralized, user-friendly and easy to navigate system. The interaction between VAP and VAPii allows Veterans to securely and safely disclose their personal information while simultaneously managing their privacy preferences.
