Connect Your Docs with Virtual Lifetime Electronic Record (VLER) Health Exchange

VLER Health Exchange is a program that shows certain parts of your VA health record between the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and non-VA health care providers. These electronic health records are shared securely and privately through the Internet using the eHealth Exchange.

Participating in VLER Health Exchange may:

- Reduce the need for you to carry paper records
- Give your provider immediate access to more of your health care information
- Reduce your chances of having duplicate tests done
- Increase your safety by providing a more complete medical record, such as your medications and allergies
- Save you time and money
- Improve your health outcomes by empowering you
