TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO ALL VETERANS AND
THEIR FAMILY MEMBERS IN FORMULATING AND
PROCESSING CLAIMS FOR COMPENSATION, PENSION,
HOSPITALIZATION, EDUCATION, BURIAL, AND
OTHER BENEFITS OR PRIVILEGES.



- Organization
- IN 1945, THE ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS WAS CREATED BY STATE LAW FOR HANDLING THE AFFAIRS OF VETERANS.
- TO FACILITATE ASSISTANCE TO VETERANS AND THEIR DEPENDENTS ON A STATEWIDE BASIS, THE ADVA MAINTAINS A DEPARTMENT HEADQUARTERS AND CENTRAL CLAIMS OFFICE IN MONTGOMERY, AND FIELD OFFICES IN EACH OF ALABAMA'S 67 COUNTIES.

CLAIMS

- THE ADVA EMPLOYS 150 VETERANS SERVICE OFFICERS THAT PROVIDE CLAIMS SERVICES TO ALABAMA'S 420,000 VETERANS, 89,787 OF WHICH ARE GULF WAR VETERANS, IN THE STATE'S 67 COUNTIES. BY STATE LAW, A VSO MUST BE A VETERAN AND RESIDE IN THE COUNTY WHERE THEY ARE EMPLOYED.
- PREPARATION OF VETERANS' CLAIMS.
- REPRESENT VETERANS IN PERSONAL APPEARANCES BEFORE THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.
- ASSISTANCE IN EXPEDITING DECISIONS FOR COMPENSATION, PENSION, EDUCATION AND TRAINING BENEFITS.

THE ADVA OPERATES THREE STATE VETERANS
HOMES IN ALEXANDER CITY, BAY MINETTE AND
HUNTSVILLE THAT PROVIDE LONG-TERM CARE TO
ALABAMA VETERANS.

ALABAMA STATE VETERANS HOMES PROGRAM

ELIGIBILITY

- AT LEAST 90 DAYS OF ACTIVE DUTY TIME OTHER THAN ANNUAL TRAINING, ACTIVE DUTY FOR TRAINING, OR INACTIVE DUTY FOR TRAINING.
- QUALIFY FOR SKILLED LONG-TERM CARE.
- RESIDENT OF ALABAMA DURING THE IMMEDIATE 12 MONTHS OF APPLYING FOR CARE.
- WARTIME VETERANS HAVE PRIORITY. PEACETIME VETERANS MAY 8
 BE ADMITTED ON A SPACE AVAILABLE BASIS.

ALABAMA STATE VETERANS HOMES PROGRAM

- 24-HOUR SKILLED LONG-TERM CARE.
- PHYSICIAN ON CALL 24/7.
- SOCIAL SERVICE PROGRAMS.
- AROUND THE CLOCK SECURITY STAFF.
- COMPASSION FOR THE VETERAN'S WELL-BEING.
- EACH VETERANS HOME PROVIDES LONG-TERM CARE FOR 150 VETERANS. PER DIEM RATE IS \$11.64 PER DAY.

ALABAMA DEPENDENTS' G.I. SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

- ENACTED IN 1951, THE ALABAMA DEPENDENTS' G.I. SCHOLARSHIP PROVIDES CHILDREN AND WIVES/WIDOWS OF DECEASED OR DISABLED VETERANS OR PRISONERS OF WAR WITH EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS IN ANY STATE-SUPPORTED COLLEGE OR TECHNICAL SCHOOL.
- PAYS FOR TUITION, BOOKS AND INSTRUCTIONAL FEES FOR FOUR ACADEMIC YEARS FOR CHILDREN, AND TWO ACADEMIC YEARS FOR SPOUSES.

ALABAMA DEPENDENTS' G.I. SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

ELIGIBILITY

- VETERAN HAS A 20% OR GREATER VA RATED DISABILITY.
- RESIDENT OF ALABAMA 12 MONTHS IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO HIS OR HER ENLISTMENT IN THE ARMED FORCES.
- THE CHILD OR SPOUSE APPLYING FOR SCHOLARSHIP BENEFITS IS THE VETERAN'S LEGAL DEPENDENT.

OTHER STATE BENEFITS

- □ AD VALOREM TAX EXEMPTION ON HOMES OF TOTALLY DISABLED PERSONS OR VETERANS AGE 65 OR OLDER WITH AN ANNUAL INCOME OF \$75,000 OR LESS.
- AD VALOREM TAX EXEMPTION ON MOTOR VEHICLES PAID FOR BY VA GRANT.
- □ STATE TAX EXEMPTION FOR MILITARY RETIREMENT PAY OR MILITARY PAY EARNED IN A COMBAT ZONE.

OTHER STATE BENEFITS

- NO REGISTRATION FEE FOR COMMEMORATIVE VEHICLE LICENSE PLATES.
- **□** FREE LICENSE PLATES FOR DISABLED VETERANS.
- □ DISCOUNTED FISHING LICENSE FOR VETERANS WITH A 20% OR GREATER VA RATED DISABILITY.

- PARTICIPATION IN THE NATIONAL GUARD AND RESERVE YELLOW RIBBON REINTERGRATION PROGRAM.
- ANNUAL PUBLIC VETERANS INFORMATION FORUMS.
- PARTNERSHIP WITH THE GOVERNOR'S GRATEFUL HEART PROGRAM.
- COMMUNITY BASED VA PUBLIC RELATIONS CAMPAIGN.

- CONSTRUCT A FOURTH STATE VETERANS HOME IN PELL CITY, ALABAMA.
- INCREASE THE ALABAMA G.I. DEPENDENT'S SCHOLARSHIP BENEFITS FROM EIGHT TO TEN SEMESTERS FOR CHILDREN, AND FROM FOUR TO SIX SEMESTERS FOR SPOUSES OF ELIGIBLE VETERANS.
- BUILD THE FIRST STATE VETERANS CEMETERY IN SOUTHWEST ALABAMA THAT WILL SERVE VETERANS AND THEIR FAMILIES FOR THE NEXT 20 YEARS.
