

**POSITION:** Physician (Geropsychiatrist), AD-602-14/15**NUMBER OF VACANCIES:** One Part-time position (40 hours per pay period)**FUNCTIONAL STATEMENT:** Physician**TYPE OF APPOINTMENT:** Temporary, Not to exceed 1 year and 1 day, may be extended or terminated sooner based on workload, budget and staffing**SALARY RANGE:** \$72,381 to \$110,682 per annum, dependent upon qualifications and experience. Salary listed is for a fulltime position. Additional special pay is available, more if a VA employee.**NOTE 1:** This agency provides reasonable accommodations to applicants with disabilities. The work conditions may require some rotation in the tour of duty**LOCATION:** This position is located in the Mental Health Division, Portland OR Division; however, it may be necessary to use the selectee's services at different locations throughout the medical center.**AREA OF CONSIDERATION:** Consideration will go to any qualified U.S. Citizen**DUTIES:** The complete Functional Statement may be reviewed in Human Resources Management Division. The following duties and responsibilities are taken from the functional statement and are considered to be a brief extract. The incumbent will function as a clinician educator and/or clinician researcher for the geropsychiatry clinic. This position will report directly to the Chief of Psychiatry/Clinical Director of Mental health. The physician is an integral part of patient care, teaching and research activities, which are shared with Oregon Health Sciences University (OHSU); as such, the physician must qualify for a faculty appointment with OHSU at assistant or associate professor. There will be an expectation that this person will have strong team-building skills.**QUALIFICATIONS:**

- ◆ Must be a citizen of the United States.
- ◆ Must be a licensed Physician with relevant work experience.
- ◆ Must have completed an ACGME approved geriatric psychiatry fellowship program.
- ◆ Must be board-certified or board eligible in geriatric psychiatry.
