RESCISSION OF VA DIRECTIVE 6000

- 1. This Notice rescinds VA Directive 6000, VA Information Resources Management (IRM) Framework. VA Directive 6000 defined an integrated VA IRM Framework process that consisted of planning, budgeting, procurement, and management-in-use of information technology (IT) investments. The process required IT investments to be measured in relation to their support of VA's mission, program goals, and objectives.
