## Introduction

The Missing Patient Register is fully compatible with Kernel version 7.0, VA MailMan 7.1 and VA FileMan 20 and makes use of components of the following packages:

DRG Grouper V10.0

MAS/PIMS V5.3

Mental Health V4.18 (not required)

Two patches are required to be installed prior to this installation. The patches are:

DG\*5.3\*46, which provides the interface between MAS and MPR, and

XM\*DBA\*47, which describes the installation of the required IPDB-

CHICAGO.VA.GOV network mailman domain.

The MPR is expected to be very low usage with .01 through-put units of capacity and less than 50K of space required.

The following should be noted for the Missing Patient Register installation:

- Installation does not require the system to be shut down
- Installation does not require the users off the system
- Installation does not require rebooting
- Remember to install routines on all CPUs necessary for your system

**NOTE: Those sites running the class III version of Missing Patient Register will see additional text during the cleanup stage of the post-init. This cleanup may include the conversion of data.**

## Post Init Actions

1. For any site doing a conversion of class III Missing Patient Register data, check messages sent to POSTMASTER. When the conversion cannot match up a missing patient with a patient's SSN in MAS a mail message is sent to POSTMASTER with the data. You will need to add these patients to Missing Patient Register file #850 using VA FileMan.
2. The mail groups MPR MESSAGES and MPR COORDINATORS were created during the post-init. Populate the mail group MPR MESSAGES with the names of IRM support staff and the mail group MPR COORDINATORS with missing patient coordinators. Problems with mail messages will initiate a message to MPR MESSAGES. Initial and Found Reports from the national database will be sent to MPR COORDINATORS. At least one active DHCP user must be in each of these mail groups.
3. Assign the MISSING PATIENT REGISTER option to designated station personnel.
4. You may delete the MPR installation routines, (MPRI\*).
