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Orientation

Manual Organization

This supplemental documentation to the Assigning Person Class to Providers (i.e., Kernel Patches XU*8.0*27 & 377) is organized into three major sections based on the following functional divisions for possible inclusion into the Kernel V. 8.0 documentation at a later date:

1. User Guide—End-user information (e.g., user options and data entry).
2. Developer Guide—Programmer-related information (e.g., APIs).
3. Systems Management Guide—Technical Information for IRM (e.g., implementation and ongoing maintenance information).

How to Use this Manual

Throughout this manual, advice and instructions are offered regarding the use of the Assigning Person Class to Providers and the functionality it provides for Veterans Health Information Systems and Technology Architecture (VistA).

This manual uses several methods to highlight different aspects of the material:

- Various symbols are used throughout the documentation to alert the reader to special information. The following table gives a description of each of these symbols:

- Descriptive text is presented in a proportional font (as represented by this font).
- Conventions for displaying TEST data in this document are as follows:
 - The first three digits (prefix) of any Social Security Numbers (SSN) will begin with either "000" or "666".
 - Patient and user names will be formatted as follows: [Application Name]PATIENT,[N] and [Application Name]USER,[N] respectively, where "Application Name" is defined in the Approved Application Abbreviations document and "N" represents the first name as a number spelled out and incremented with each new entry. For example, in Kernel (KRN) test patient and user names would be documented as follows: KRNPATIENT,ONE; KRNPATIENT,TWO; KRNPATIENT,THREE; etc.

- "Snapshots" of computer online displays (i.e., roll-and-scroll screen captures/dialogs) and computer source code are shown in a *non*-proportional font and enclosed within a box. Also included are Graphical User Interface (GUI) Microsoft Windows images (i.e., dialogues or forms).
 - User's responses to online prompts will be boldface type.
 - The "<Enter>" found within these snapshots indicate that the user should press the Enter or Return key on their keyboard.
 - Author's comments are displayed in italics or as "callout" boxes.



NOTE: Callout boxes refer to labels or descriptions usually enclosed within a box, which point to specific areas of a displayed image.

- Object Pascal code uses a combination of upper- and lowercase characters. All Object Pascal reserved words are in boldface type.
- All uppercase is reserved for the representation of M code, variable names, or the formal name of options, field and file names, and security keys (e.g., the XUPROGMODE key).

How to Obtain Technical Information Online

Exported file, routine, and global documentation can be generated through the use of Kernel, MailMan, and VA FileMan utilities.



NOTE: Methods of obtaining specific technical information online will be indicated where applicable under the appropriate topic.

Help at Prompts

Kernel has online help and commonly used system default prompts. Users are strongly encouraged to enter question marks at any response prompt. At the end of the help display, you are immediately returned to the point from which you started. This is an easy way to learn about any aspect of Kernel.

To retrieve online documentation in the form of Help in Kernel:

- Enter a single question mark ("?") at a field/prompt to obtain a brief description. If a field is a pointer, entering one question mark ("?") displays the HELP PROMPT field contents and a list of choices, if the list is short. If the list is long, the user will be asked if the entire list should be displayed. A YES response will invoke the display. The display can be given a starting point by prefacing the starting point with an up-arrow ("^") as a response. For example, **^M** would start an alphabetic listing at the letter M instead of the letter A while **^127** would start any listing at the 127th entry.
- Enter two question marks ("??") at a field/prompt for a more detailed description. Also, if a field is a pointer, entering two question marks displays the HELP PROMPT field contents and the list of choices.

- Enter three question marks ("???) at a field/prompt to invoke any additional Help text that may be stored in Help Frames.

Obtaining Data Dictionary Listings

Technical information about files and the fields in files is stored in data dictionaries. You can use the List File Attributes option on the Data Dictionary Utilities submenu in VA FileMan to print formatted data dictionaries.

Assumptions About the Reader

This manual is written with the assumption that the reader is familiar with the following:

- VistA computing environment (e.g., Kernel Installation and Distribution System [KIDS])
- VA FileMan data structures and terminology
- Microsoft Windows
- M programming language

It provides an overall explanation of the use, maintenance, and implementation of the Assigning Person Class to Providers Software and the changes contained in Kernel Patches XU*8.0*27 & 377. However, no attempt is made to explain how the overall VistA programming system is integrated and maintained. Such methods and procedures are documented elsewhere. We suggest you look at the various VA home pages on the World Wide Web (WWW) for a general orientation to VistA. I. User Guide

This is the User Guide section of this supplemental documentation for the Assigning Person Class to Providers software (i.e., Kernel Patches XU*8.0*27 and 377). It is intended for use in conjunction with the software patches associated with Assigning Person Class to Providers. It details the user-related documentation associated with the Assigning Person Class to Providers software (e.g., overview of the Assigning Person Class to Providers software), management of the Assigning Person Class to Providers software, etc.).

1. Introduction—Assigning Person Class to Providers

As of October 1996, VHA facilities were required to report each ambulatory encounter and/or ancillary service. Provider, procedure, and diagnosis information is included in the minimum data set reported to the National Patient Care Database (NPCD). The provider information reported is the "Person Class" defined for all providers associated with ambulatory care delivery.

To comply with this requirement, all VA Medical Center (VAMC) providers were assigned a Profession/Occupation code (i.e., Person Class) so that a Person Class could be associated with each ambulatory patient encounter by October 1, 1996.

Kernel Patch XU*8.0*27 was originally developed to provide the functionality that enabled facilities to assign Person Class information. Kernel Patch XU*8.0*377 was developed in order to update the Person Class data and related documentation.

2. Entering Person Class Data

Kernel Patches XU*8.0*27 and 377 enable users to enter Person Class data for providers in four easy steps:

Step #1—Identify All Providers—Identify all providers currently associated with the clinics (e.g., physicians, nurses, psychologists, social workers, etc.) for whom you need to enter Person Class information.

Step #2—Assign the appropriate Person Class to each provider associated with the clinics.

Step #3—Enter the Person Class—Enter the Person Class by using the User PC build Edit option for the initial assigning of Person Class information for all providers.

Step #4—Edit Person Class—After initial data entry for your providers, edit the Person Class data for any individual as needed.

These steps are described in greater detail in the topics that follow.

Step #1—Identify All Providers

Identify all providers currently associated with the clinics (e.g., physicians, nurses, psychologists, social workers, etc.) for whom you need to enter Person Class information.

- This is a task that will probably be done only once. It is only needed for the printout of a worksheet to record information on paper for faster data entry later.
- Use the User PC build Print option on your secondary menu to print a list of providers who need to have the Person Class data entered. This option can be assigned to any user. The list includes individuals in the NEW PERSON file (#200) who have been assigned the Provider security key and who have a current Verify Code (i.e., they must both be a Provider and be active on the system). The printout will show the PROVIDER CLASS and PROVIDER TYPE for each individual listed.

Example

If you print to your screen, you will see something similar to the following:

Step #2—Assigning Person Class to Providers

Assign the appropriate Person Class to each provider associated with the clinics.

Print the Person Class file using FileMan print (Print File Entries option), so that you have the classifications and codes. Like Step #Step #1—Identify All Providers, this step is a one-time task.

Step #3—Enter the Person Class

Enter the Person Class by using the User PC build Edit option for the initial assigning of Person Class information for all providers.

- The data input task is a simple one and can be assigned to anyone who will perform this task. Users should use the User PC build Edit option, which is a rapid data entry capable option.
- The provider classification system or taxonomy adopted by VHA is hierarchical and classifies providers into aggregate groupings:
 - Services
 - Provider Types
 - Areas of Specialization or Focus

The taxonomy represents a one-to-many relationship to the individual provider. Many occurrences of the taxonomy may apply to a single provider. For example, a provider who trains in Internal Medicine and specializes in Cardiology may appear with specialties in both Internal Medicine and Cardiology (two occurrences of the taxonomy relating to one provider). VHA assigns only one Person Class to each provider, and in the example above, Cardiology would be the assigned Person Class as it is the most specific.

- This function allows only one active provider type during any one period of time.
- You do *not* have to enter a Person Class code for inactive providers.
- If the Enter on Duty Date is known, it should be entered in the Effective Date field. If the Enter on Duty Date is *not* known and the individual has been at the facility at least a year, we suggest that you enter a date one year prior to the current date.
- When you add a new Person Class entry to a provider who already has one defined, it is not necessary to enter the expiration date of the previous Person Class. The program automatically inserts the effective date of the new Person Class as the previous Expiration date.

Example

Select the User PC build Edit option on your secondary menu and enter the name of the individual for whom you want to add or edit Person Class.

Step #4—Edit Person Class

After initial data entry for your providers, edit the Person Class data for any individual as needed.

- There are three options that can be used to edit Person Class data:
 - Person Class Edit option [XU-PERSON CLASS EDIT]
 - User PC build Edit option [XUSER PC BUILD EDIT], as in Step #3—Enter the Person Class
 - Edit an Existing User option [XUSEREDIT] on the User Management menu [XUSER], locked with the XUPROG security key.
- We recommend using the Person Class Edit option [XU-PERSON CLASS EDIT]. Once the Person Class has been entered for any provider, you can enter an additional or new Person Class by using the Person Class Edit option.
- Previous entries *must* remain on file for historical and legal purposes. You *cannot* delete or replace old entries. That is, you *cannot* modify the Person Class field itself; you may, however, change the Effective or Expired Date.
- When you add a new entry to a provider who already has a Person Class entered, it is not necessary to enter the Expired Date for the previous Person Class. The software automatically inserts the Effective Date of the new Person Class as the Expired Date of the previous Person Class.

Example

Select the Person Class Edit option [XU-PERSON CLASS EDIT] from your menu and you will see the following prompt:

In this case, the user has two assigned Person Classes. Use the arrow or tab keys to select the Person Class data line you wish to edit. Once the line is highlighted, expanded descriptive text for that Person Class appears near the bottom of the screen. If you want to add a new Person Class, tab to the first blank Person Class line and type the name or the number of the specialty.

The message at the bottom of the screen (Figure 2-12) confirms that you want to add a new Person Class. If you answer YES, the screen will show that specialty under Person Class and will insert today's date in the Effective date field. You can edit that date or leave it as is and then tab over to the Expired date field of the Person Class.

Deactivate/Reactivate a User

IRM has options to deactivate and reactivate a user on the system:

- Reactivate a User option [XUSERREACT]
- Deactivate a User option [XUSERDEACT]

These options are both located on the User Management menu. They are used when a provider leaves or returns to a VA site.

For example, when someone, such as a medical student, rotates out, IRM deactivates their account via the Deactivate a User option [XUSERDEACT]. The Reactivate a User option [XUSERREACT] gives IRM the opportunity to edit a provider's Person Class information. If the provider rotates in again, their Person Class information can be updated when they are reactivated.

HCFA Provider Codes

The Health Care Financing Administration (HCFA) provider classification system or taxonomy adopted by VHA is hierarchical and classifies providers into aggregate groupings:

- Services
- Provider types
- Areas of specialization or focus

The taxonomy represents a one-to-many relationship to the individual provider. Many occurrences of the taxonomy may apply to a single provider. For example, a provider who trains in Internal Medicine and specializes in Cardiology may appear with specialties in both Internal Medicine and Cardiology (two occurrences of the taxonomy relating to one provider). VHA assigns only one Person Class to each provider, and in the example above, Cardiology would be the assigned Person Class as it is the more specific.

The PERSON CLASS Multiple field (200.05#) in the NEW PERSON file (#200) contains entries that reflect the assignment of HCFA taxonomy to providers. Each entry contains three data elements:

- PERSON CLASS field (#.01)—Pointer to PERSON CLASS file (#8932.1).
- EFFECTIVE DATE field (#.02)—Date the code took effect.
- EXPIRATION DATE field (#.03)—Date the code ceased/expired/was replaced.

Entry of a new person in the NEW PERSON file (#200) will ask for input of the aforementioned multiple, the current occupation/profession. Entering a history is optional.

Deactivate/Reactivate a User

The Reactivate option on the User Management menu, used when a provider returns to a VA site (e.g., a medical student), gives the IRM staff the opportunity to edit the Person Class information. For example, when someone, such as a medical student, rotates out, they are deactivated. If they rotate in again, their Person Class information can be updated when they are reactivated.

IRM Edits of Person Class Data

If an IRM staff member is to edit the Person Class data, they should use the Edit an Existing User option on the User Management menu. Person Class data is on the third screen, as shown below:
