



PROBLEM

53-year-old female, caregiver of Navy Veteran: "They're not getting help, or they're going to doctors that have never even heard of Gulf War Illness, that's usually the case. I think everybody needs to know what Gulf War Illness is." 55-year-old female, Army Veteran: "We really just need to be believed. They need a doctor, or the system to believe that there really could be something wrong with them, and it really could be service connected."





- Development of educational resources is not enough.
- Despite education on GWI being available, uptake is low.
- Clinicians do not feel there is system level support for improving knowledge of and care for GWI.



We propose to develop and implement a multimodal GWI awareness initiative

1. Enhance clinician recognition of GWI.

2. Support clinicians so that they are better equipped to engage patients with GWI.
