My HealthVet Release 12.5.1 includes key enhancements to the VA Blue Button/ VA CCD:

- More timely access to information by reducing the 'hold periods' for two VA data classes included in the VA CCD (Problem List and Laboratory Results) from 7 calendar days to 3 calendar days. These changes synchronize the hold period business rules for the VA CCD with the VA Blue Button.
- Enhanced user-friendly section descriptions in the VA CCD Style Sheet and PDF view.
- Re-enablement of the PDF file format for the VA Blue Button and VA CCD.
  - Cautionary content added to the user interface
  - New View/Print button for the PDF format with inline PDF viewer
  - Pop-up window presented to users when they choose the Download PDF button, enabling them to view cautionary content then continue or cancel

Sample VA Blue Button files are provided to illustrate the VA Blue Button and VA CCD output. Release notes and sample files will be updated as changes occur, and these updates are posted on the VA Blue Button website at [www.va.gov/bluebutton](http://www.va.gov/bluebutton).

History of Encounters*	This section contains a list of completed VA Outpatient Encounters for the patient, along with the titles of the associated VA Notes. The data comes from all VA treatment facilities. It includes the 25 most recent Encounter dates within the last 36 months. There is a limit of 10 Note titles for each Encounter. History of Procedures*	This section contains Procedures performed at VA for the patient. It shows surgical and radiological procedures. Problems/Conditions*	This section contains a list of Problems/Conditions known to VA for the patient. It includes both active and inactive problems/conditions.
