This does not refer to the expiration date of the medication in the container. Non-VA=A medication that came from someplace other than a VA pharmacy. This may be a prescription from either the VA or other providers that was filled outside the VA. Or, it may be an over the counter (OTC), herbal, dietary supplement or sample medication. Pending=This prescription order has been sent to the Pharmacy for review and is not ready yet.
