
Timeline of U.S. Period of Service Eras (1900-Present)*

VHA Office of Health Equity (OHE) distinguishes two Gulf War periods (portrayed in gray brackets): "Gulf War (Other)" is the period from the start of the Persian Gulf War to the start of Operation Enduring Freedom (August 2, 1990 – October 6, 2001), while "Gulf War (OEF/OIF/OND)" includes the OEF/OIF/OND conflict beginning on October 7, 2001 and still ongoing as of the date this document was prepared 1/10/2015 and as of latest update (02/10/2017).
