- Ineligible Expense of the month
  - Finding: Sample testing revealed Grantee improperly charged the GPD program for loan interest expense.
  - Guidance: **2 CFR 200 Subpart E, Cost Principles 200.449(a)** Interest states, *“Costs incurred for interest on borrowed capital, temporary use of endowment funds, or the use of the non-Federal entity’s own funds, however represented, are unallowable.”*
