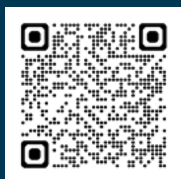


## Resources

The **Veterans Pension** program helps wartime Veterans and their families cope with financial challenges by providing monthly supplemental income.

- To qualify, a Veteran must meet certain age or disability requirements and have income and net worth within certain limits. For more eligibility information, visit [www.va.gov/pension/](http://www.va.gov/pension/)



**VA Disability Compensation** provides tax-free monthly payments to Veterans with disabilities that are the result of a disease or injury incurred or aggravated during active military service.

To qualify, a Veteran must have:

- **Current Diagnosis:** You must have a current diagnosis of the disability.
- **In-Service Event:** There must be evidence of an in-service event, injury, or illness.
- **Nexus:** A medical nexus must link the current disability to the in-service event.

**Veteran Readiness and Employment Services (VR&E)** provides services to eligible Service members and Veterans with service-connected disabilities and an employment handicap to help them to prepare for, obtain, and maintain suitable employment. For those with service-connected disabilities so severe that they cannot immediately consider work, VR&E provides services to improve their ability to live as independently as possible.

## General Eligibility

VA benefits is based on the character of discharge from active military service.
