SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR VETERAN FAMILIES (SSVF) GRANTEE ORIENTATION GUIDE

INTRODUCTION

The primary purpose of this guide is to provide a basic set of orientation and training resources for organizations that have received SSVF program funds for the first time. Existing SSVF grantees may also use these resources to guide introductory training for new staff. The guide aims to provide an introductory framework of SSVF including: program requirements, program practices and philosophies, examples of grantee best practices in the field, and useful tools for program start-up and implementation. This guide uses materials that were produced over a multi-year period and in many instances only offers an introductory overview of the concepts, practices, and requirements of the SSVF program. In some cases, these materials were repurposed from previous trainings to fit the needs of orienting new SSVF grantees.

Please understand that this guide is not exhaustive of all of the resources and training materials available to SSVF grantees. SSVF University, which can found at www.va.gov/homeless/ssvf, includes a full listing of tools and resources available to SSVF grantees, regardless of their implementation stage or program sophistication.

REQUIREMENTS

<u>All staff</u> of grantees who received SSVF funds for the first time in fall of 2014 are **required** to review each of the videos and resources presented in this guide <u>within three weeks</u> of the date of release of this document. All staff that completed the training should be listed on the certification form on page eight. Grantees are encouraged to view all activities in the order they appear. Once all SSVF staff members of new SSVF grantees review the material, program directors (or designees) are required to "check off" that all of the modules were completed and either electronically or physically sign the document to certify completion of the training. Upon completion, the training checklist, including the signed certification form, must be submitted to the grantee's VA Regional Coordinator for official record. Existing grantees with new staff are also strongly encouraged to use this document when providing basic training and orientation, or to refresh existing staff on specific content areas. However, these renewal grantees are not required to submit the signed certification of completion to their Regional Coordinator.

QUESTIONS

The VA SSVF Program Office and Regional Coordinators will provide an opportunity for new grantees to directly ask questions in the coming weeks. The question and answer session will either be through a national webinar or on individual calls with each grantee's respective Regional Coordinator, or both.
