



Locating Electronic Resources with the A to Z List

What is an A to Z List?

An A to Z List compiles all of the online journals, books and databases made available to you by your VA medical center library, VISN, and the Library Network Office in one convenient place. Each VA medical center library has a unique A to Z List. Search the A to Z List to find journals and books by title; search within databases to find articles on specific topics.

Locate Your A to Z List

There are several ways to locate your VA medical center library's A to Z List, depending on whether you are working onsite or at home.

On-site

When onsite, you can access your library's A to Z List from your VA medical center library's intranet site, or by consulting the [Find Journals and Books](#) page of the VHA National Desktop Library.

Off-site

When offsite, you can access your library's A to Z List by logging into [Athens Authentication](#) remote access, and selecting ***A to Z List of Ejournal and Ebooks available to [VA medical center]** at the top of the Resources list. Search the A to Z List

Title, ISSN or ISBN

Search journals and books by title, ISSN or ISBN by entering your search into the search box and selecting the type of search from the drop down menu. You must search by journal or book title; you cannot search by article title here.

Find resources by journal or book title

If you already have a citation and want full text, try [Citation Linker](#)

DOI or PubMed ID

Search by DOI (Digital Object Identifier) or PubMed ID to retrieve full-text instantaneously. Click the [What is DOI?](#) or [What is PubMed?](#) hyperlink to learn more about these article identifiers.

Access Full-Text

Access Online Journals

Once you have results from searching or browsing, select the hyperlinked journal source whose coverage dates match the citation or period of interest. Navigate the selected database or publisher website to locate and download the article of interest, search for articles on a topic, or browse available journal issues. Downloading differs from website to website; your VA medical center library staff can assist you in locating and downloading articles.
