Minneapolis Research Week 2024 will be held May 28-30

Abstract Submission Process:

- 1. Select your preferred presentation format (see below)
- 2. Fill the Abstract Submission Form (please use Adobe Acrobat/Adobe Pro only)
- 3. Send the completed form by email to VHAMINResearchOffice@va.gov

You WILL NOT get a confirmation email that your abstract was received. We cannot respond manually to each submission. To confirm receipt, cc yourself on the email, and/or request delivery confirmation in Outlook (Options → Request a delivery receipt) before hitting Send.

Presentations should be for VA research projects. **QI projects should be presented at Education Week.**

Deadlines:

- Abstracts for posters and oral presentations: **Tuesday April 30**Submissions that miss this deadline will not be included in the abstract booklet
- Poster submission deadline: Friday May 10
 Submissions that miss this deadline will not be printed by Medical Media

Presentation Format: All presenters should plan on a poster presentation for 2023. Oral presentations will be offered on a first-come, first-served basis. If not selected for oral presentation, you should plan to submit a poster.

- Poster presentations: To be held May 30 and made available on VA network
 - o Poster dimensions are limited to 36" wide due to limited poster board space.
 - o Preferred format is 36" wide by 48" tall. A template for this size is provided (see below).
 - o Final poster must be submitted as a PDF (File → Save As → PDF in PowerPoint, or "Save as Adobe PDF" if Acrobat Pro is available)
- Oral Presentations: To be held May 29
 - o Limited to 10 minutes, to be submitted in PowerPoint format
 - Must include title slide with project title, personnel, and affiliations, plus no more than 5 slides of data. A single credits/acknowledgements slide at end is acceptable and does not count towards the 5 slide limit.

We encourage (but do not require) use of the slide presentation/poster templates available on the VA network at "R:\All_Staff\Research Week".

Abstract Submission Instructions:

- <u>Please use only Adobe Reader/Adobe Pro to fill and submit the form.</u> Other PDF viewers do not save the form in a format that allows us to extract the data after submission.
- <u>Please only enter author institutions, not departments.</u> Use drop-down menu in form for VA/UMN affiliation. You can list full departmental affiliations on your presentation, but only institution will be included in the abstract booklet.
- <u>Please enter your abstract as a single paragraph of text.</u> All submissions will be formatted as one paragraph in the abstract booklet. Formatting, bullet points, and images should not be included and will be removed in the final abstract. Abstracts are limited to 2500 characters.
