**RESCISSION OF VHA DIRECTIVE 1732, REPORTING MEDICAL CARE
COLLECTION FUNDS COST TO COLLECT**

1. By direction of the Office of the Under Secretary for Health, Veterans Health Administration (VHA), VHA Directive 1732, Reporting Medical Care Collection Funds Cost to Collect, dated May 12, 2016, is rescinded.
