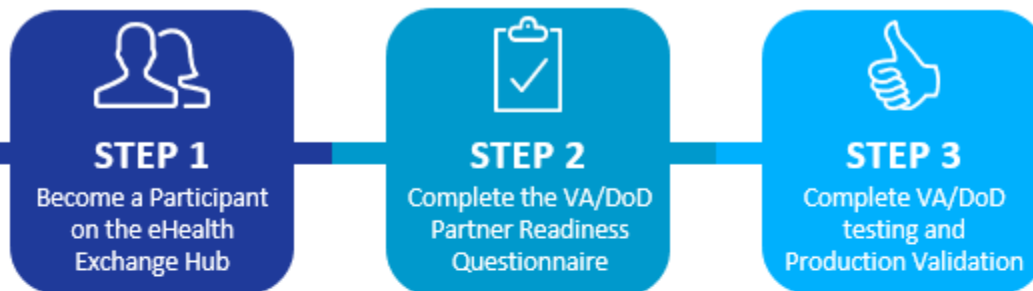
Benefits of the Joint HIE

- Provides VA, DoD, and community providers with a comprehensive summary of a Veteran's health
- Eliminates unnecessary medical tests

Documents Exchanged

- CCDs containing data such as allergies, medications, problems and conditions
- Encounter Summaries containing notes relevant to specific patient encounters
