Are you accepting civilian/humanitarian patients?

- Jesse Brown received its' first humanitarian case 4/17/2020.
- Ann Arbor has about 20 humanitarian patients, as of 4/14

Was the angioedema you described generalized, or just facial?

- The angioedema patient was top/bottom lip only. ENT didn't scope because of exposure risk. But breathing was not distressed. No voice change, etc. This was a stable angioedema patient on ED presentation.

Are you utilizing prone positioning?

- Currently they are not proning in the ICU in Detroit.
- Jesse Brown (Chicago) does have a proning team in the MICU.
