





Dr. Janet Han is an Associate Professor of Medicine at UCLA and a cardiac electrophysiologist at the VA Greater Los Angeles Healthcare System, where she also serves as the Director of the Digital Health Program for the Cardiac Arrhythmia Service. She is actively involved in several national committees including the American College of Cardiology Digital Strategy Transformation Committee in the American College of Cardiology, COVID-19 Task Force and Communications Committee of the Heart Rhythm Society, and the AF Systems of Care Advisory Group of the American Heart Association.





Dr. Krishna Reddy

Dr. Reddy currently works as an Orthopedic Surgeon at Cincinnati VA Medical Center and Assistant Professor in the Department of Orthopedics at the University of Cincinnati. His specialties include Musculoskeletal Oncology, Sports medicine, shoulder reconstruction and General orthopedics, including primary and revision arthroplasty. He graduated from orthopedic residency from one of the top medical schools in India before moving to United Kingdom on a British Council sponsorship in 2002. He is a Fellow of the prestigious Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh (Trauma & Orthopedics) and obtained his Musculoskeletal Oncology training from the renowned Royal Orthopedic Hospital in Birmingham, UK.
