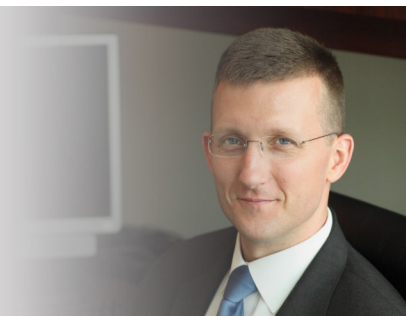




VA | Careers and employment

VA Serves Veterans

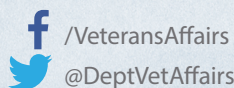
In gratitude for your honorable service to our nation, VA provides benefits to help you buy, maintain, or modify a home; earn a degree; start a career; stay healthy; and do so much more in life after the military.

Here are a few VA employment services to explore:

- **Job and career assistance.** VA can support you in all stages of your job search—from returning to work with a service-connected disability, to getting more training for new job opportunities, to starting or growing your own business. And we can connect you with Department of Labor resources for more career advice, help building your resume, and access to employers who want to hire Veterans and military spouses.
- **Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment (VR&E) services.** If you are a qualified Veteran with service-connected disabilities or a transitioning service member, VR&E services can help you prepare for, find and keep a suitable job. Your VR&E counselor will coordinate your services, including counseling, education, employment, and health care, and guide you every step of the way. If your service-connected disability prevents you from working, VR&E services can help you stay productive and healthy.
