Did You Know...

- VA disability compensation benefits are tax-free.
- Your monthly payments may be higher if you have a dependent spouse, children, or parents.
- Your disability rating may open the door to other VA benefits.

VA Serves Veterans

In gratitude for your honorable service to our nation, VA helps you buy, retain, or modify a home; earn a degree; start a career; stay healthy; and do so much more in life after the military.

Here are a few disability compensation benefits to explore:

- Compensation for the average earnings loss associated with your disability. Disability ratings— issued by VA in increments of 10 ranging from 0 percent to 100 percent—are intended to compensate for loss in earnings capacity and, in some instances, may entitle you to other VA benefits.
- **Allowances for in-home care.** You may need an outside caregiver because of your service-connected disability. If so, VA may offer additional payments beyond your base compensation amount.
- **Assistance with transportation and equipment.** Certain service-connected disabilities may affect your mobility. In some cases, VA provides payments to help you buy a vehicle or equip a vehicle with power brakes, power steering, or other equipment to make it easier to get around.
- **Health care and other benefits.** As a service-disabled Veteran you may be entitled to free health care, employment counseling, education and training, and other benefits.

Payments vary depending on the severity of your disability, which must be supported by evidence and military records. The fastest way to receive a claims decision is by filing a fully developed eClaim (FDC) at **VA.gov**.
