



Montana VA Health Care System (MVAHCS) provides a VA presence in every major city in the state through a series of community based clinics, a community living center, and an acute care medical center and is the fourth largest state geographically for one of the largest per capita Veteran populations.

Primary care is provided at Anaconda, Billings, Bozeman, Cutbank, Glasgow, Glendive, Great Falls, Havre, Kalispell, Lewistown, Miles City, and Missoula. Primary Care Telehealth Outreach Clinics are located in Hamilton and Plentywood. Fort Harrison (Helena) is a 34-bed acute care, medical-surgical facility that offers a broad range of services. The 24-bed inpatient mental health facility serves patients needing treatment for PTSD and Substance Abuse. A 30-bed Community Living Center (CLC) that provides general and ventilator dependent care is located in Miles City. Staff and contract specialists visit the clinics regularly and provide access to specialty care as needed.

Sheridan VA Health Care System (SVAHCS) serves Veterans across three quarters of Wyoming and the Rocky Mountain Region. The system's main facility is in Sheridan. Its 185-bed medical center serves as the psychiatry tertiary referral site for VISN 19. The bed complement includes 20 psychiatric, 10 medical, 40 extended care, 70 mental health residential beds, and a 45-bed Domiciliary Residential Treatment program for Homeless Veterans.

We have **five (5) Community Based Outpatient Clinics** located in Casper, Riverton, Cody (contracted), Gillette, and Rock Springs, Wyoming; **two (2) Telehealth Outreach Clinics** located in Worland and Evanston, Wyoming; and **one (1) Outreach Clinic** in Afton, Wyoming. Sheridan has been fortunate in attracting a nucleus of excellent board-certified physicians and other licensed, independent practitioners, complemented by a variety of community specialty partners.

The Cheyenne VA Health Care System serves Veterans in one of the largest geographical service areas in the VA system and consists of our main facility in Cheyenne, Wyoming and **four (4) community clinics** located in Ft. Collins, Loveland and Rawlins, Wyoming, and Sidney, Nebraska; **four (4) mobile telehealth clinics** located in Laramie, Sterling, Torrington and Wheatland, Wyoming. The Medical Center provides primary and secondary inpatient medicine and surgery services; as well as outpatient services in numerous specialty care and social support areas.





Native American Veterans are seen at any of the four Utah Navajo Health System Clinics in Southeast Utah.

The WCHCS provides a full range of services including medical, surgical, psychiatric, physical rehabilitation, dental, comprehensive pain management, intense outpatient substance abuse, as well as inpatient medical surgical hospital, a hospice unit and a Community Living Center (CLC). The facility has **55 inpatient beds** and **five emergency room beds**.



We have a strong academic affiliation with the University of Colorado, which supports more than **160 medical residents** and trains more than **400 allied professionals**.



**Oklahoma City VA Health Care System (VAHCS)** consists of a **192-operating bed** facility located in central Oklahoma serving forty-eight Oklahoma counties and two counties in north central Texas (Wilbarger and Wichita). The Oklahoma City VAHCS includes outpatient clinics in Ada, Altus, Ardmore, Blackwell, Enid, Lawton, Oklahoma City, Stillwater, and Wichita Falls. The Oklahoma City VAHCS is a tertiary care facility, classified as a VA complexity level rating of 1b and is a teaching hospital, providing a full range of patient care services, with state-of-the-art technology as well as education and research.

Comprehensive health care is provided through primary care, tertiary care, and long-term care. The Oklahoma City VAHCS has specialized programs including Mental Health Intensive Case Management (MHICM), Reaching Out to Educate and Assist Health Care Families (REACH), Compensated Work Therapy, Center for Alzheimer and Neurodegenerative Diseases (CANDO), and Animal Assisted Therapy.

The Eastern Oklahoma VA Health Care System (EOVAHCS) serves more than **47,000 Veterans** in 25 counties in eastern Oklahoma. The main facility, Jack C.
