VA Nebraska-Western Iowa Health Care System Ambulatory Care Center Fast Facts

- Three-Story, 157,000-square foot outpatient expansion to the Omaha VA Medical Center Campus, representing the largest addition in the history of the facility.
- Projected to serve up to an additional 400 outpatient visits per day.
- Total Cost: \$86 million (\$56 million Federal; \$30 million Private).
- The Ambulatory Care Center is home to:
 - Primary Care Clinics (Three)
 - Dedicated Women's Health Clinic (*First for VA Nebraska-Western Iowa Health Care System*)
 - Radiology
 - Dedicated Ambulatory Surgery (Five new operating rooms).
 - Specialty Clinics
 - Dermatology
 - Neurology
 - Infectious Disease
 - Endocrinology
 - Allergy
- The Ambulatory Care Center includes numerous Veteran-themed design aspects such as:
