- Doctor of pharmacy degree from ACPE- accredited school of pharmacy
- Eligible for pharmacy licensure in US or DC
- US citizen
- Academic transcripts (PharmD only)
- Curriculum vitae
- Minimum GPA 3.0
- Letter of intent (address questions below)
 - Why do you want to complete your residency with the program?
 - What are your areas of clinical interest?

 - PGY2 candidates must have reference from the PGY1 RPD

Appointment is contingent upon satisfactory completion of a physical exam, including negative drug test. Applicants must meet requirements for federal employment, including US Citizenship. Residents are required to obtain a pharmacist's license in any state by October 1st, however, it is strongly encouraged that residents are licensed by program start date.
