VA Central Iowa Healthcare System is dedicated to improving the lives of Veterans and their families every day by providing health care services at 9 locations in central Iowa. Facilities include our Des Moines VA Medical Center with 229 beds (51 hospital, 10 acute psychiatric, 108 nursing and rehabilitation, and 60 domiciliary) and community-based outpatient clinics in Carroll, Fort Dodge, Knoxville, Marshalltown, and Mason City. We have one VA Mobile Clinic – which we use to expand health services for Veterans living in rural areas.

The Des Moines VA Medical Center includes state-of-the-art ambulatory care clinics, operating rooms, intensive care units, laboratory, and diagnostic facilities. As a leader in healthcare education with a teaching hospital providing a full range of services, VACIHCS is affiliated with the University of Iowa College of Medicine, Des Moines University, Des Moines Area Medical Education Consortium, Inc., and other universities and professional schools throughout the United States. VACIHCS has a large, well-funded research and development program that includes studies in biomedical research, health services, clinical and cooperative studies, and rehabilitation with over 220 active research projects in areas like Infectious Disease, Diabetes, Autoimmune Disorders, Cardiology, Hypertension, Schizophrenia, Hematology, Oncology, and Surgery.
