- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 from your nursing program
- Have no prior RN experience
- Obtain a current, unrestricted RN license prior to start of the program
- Be proficient in both spoken and written English
- Pass the VA pre-employment medical exam and drug testing
- Commit to completing the 1-year PB-RNR Program
