## Certified Educator Training

The goal of the ACPE Certification Process is to produce ACPE Certified Educators who are competent to provide effective professional services and who strive for excellence in their professional work.

The Certification Process is designed as a developmental, competency-based approach to learning. In this approach, evaluation of CECs is ongoing and is grounded in clearly articulated competencies that are required to successfully engage in this work. Competency-based learning utilizes systems of instruction, assessment and reporting that are based on students demonstrating that they have learned the knowledge and skills they are expected to learn as they progress through the process.

### Qualifications for a Fellowship

- A completed Application for Certified Educator Programs [https://acpe.edu/docs/default-source/certification/2020cecappliation.docx?sfvrsn=4cec46c\\_2](https://acpe.edu/docs/default-source/certification/2020cecappliation.docx?sfvrsn=4cec46c_2)
- College graduation
- Graduate theological degree or its equivalent
- Ordination or commissioning to function as a spiritual care provider by an appropriate religious/spiritual authority as determined by ACPE
- Endorsement/statement of accountability from an appropriate religious/spiritual authority as determined by ACPE
- Successful completion of a minimum of four units of Level I/Level II ACPE CPE (two units at Level II)
- Demonstration of spiritual care and conceptual competence as evidenced by the attainment/completion of Level I/Level II Outcomes
- Evaluation of the competencies for admission to a Certified Educator Program
