Veteran Health Indiana to Host Virtual Veteran Town Hall on PACT Act 2022

Veteran Health Indiana will host a Virtual Veteran Town Hall on Monday, October 17, at 6 p.m., to discuss with all Veterans the Sergeant First Class Heath Robinson Honoring our Promise to Address Comprehensive Toxics (PACT) Act of 2022, which was signed into law on August 10, 2022.

The new law expands VA health care and benefits for Veterans exposed to burn pits and other toxic substances and it empowers VA to provide generations of Veterans – and their survivors – with the care and benefits they have earned.
