

PGY1 PHARMACY RESIDENCY PROGRAM

The Orlando VA HealthCare System (OVAHCS) ASHP-accredited postgraduate year one (PGY1) program is a 12-month program offering a range of experiences to support resident professional growth and development.

The primary practice site during the residency is the Lake Nona campus. However, residents will have the opportunity to select a Patient Aligned Care Team elective at an OVAHCS Community Based Outpatient Clinic.

OVAHCS residents will have numerous opportunities to be involved in patient care, education, clinical and administrative projects as well as local committees. Residents are required to complete a residency project and present their projects at a professional meeting. Residents are required to submit a manuscript suitable for publication by the end of the residency.

ABOUT ORLANDO VA HEALTHCARE SYSTEM

The Orlando VA was established as a medical center in October 2006 and has grown exponentially since that time. The main medical center in Lake Nona is part of a 650-acre health and life sciences park known as Medical City. The medical center has 134-inpatient beds and provides acute care, complex specialty care, advanced diagnostic services, a large multispecialty outpatient clinic, and administrative and support services. The Orlando VA Healthcare System also includes a 120-bed Community Living Center in Lake Nona; Residential Rehabilitation Programs (Domiciliaries) in Lake Nona and Lake Baldwin; Outpatient Clinics in Lake Baldwin, Viera and Daytona Beach; and five Community Based Outpatient Clinics located in Clermont, Deltona, Kissimmee, Palm Bay, and Tavares.

Pharmacy Residency Positions

The Orlando VA Healthcare System is seeking **SIX** highly motivated postgraduate year one (PGY1) Pharmacy Residency Program candidates. The goal of this program is to develop proficient pharmacy practitioners with excellent practice skills and leadership abilities.

Requirements

- ◆ Graduate of ACPE accredited school of pharmacy with a Pharm.D. or other advanced degree
- ◆ Hold an active pharmacy license, or be eligible for licensure
- ◆ Candidates must be U.S. citizens
- ◆ Live Interview (Virtual)

Application Requirements

- ◆ **Applications must be submitted by January 2nd**
- ◆ Completed PhORCAS application, including:
 - ✓ Curriculum Vitae
 - ✓ Pharmacy school transcripts
 - ✓ Three professional references utilizing the PhORCAS standard form with narrative comment section completed.
 - ✓ Supplemental questions (see ASHP Directory listing for information)

Salary & Benefits

The annual stipend is ~\$41,742. Benefits include paid annual and sick leave, 11 paid federal holidays, paid time off to attend select professional meetings, and a health care benefits package.
