VA Mission:

Location:

VAMC Lebanon's main campus is located in South Lebanon Township, 3 miles outside the city of Lebanon and approximately 30 miles east of Harrisburg, the state capital, and 30 minutes from the cities of Hershey, Reading, Lancaster, and York.

Benefits

- ★ Full time RNs earn 26 vacation days/year
- ★ Full time RNs earn 13 sick leave days/year with no limits on accumulation and can be used towards retirement years
- ★ 11 paid federal holidays
- ★ Shift differential: 10% (Evening, Night shift) & 25% (weekends), double time for holidays
- ★ Federal retirement system (Pension)
- ★ Travel and work in any state license is valid for employment. (For example a Texas license is valid in PA)
- ★ On-site child care with employee discount
- ★ Federal health insurance
- ★ Federal dental and vision insurance
- ★ Thrift savings plan (similar to a 401 K) -The VA will contribute 1% to your account automatically, plus match your contributions up to 4% (dollar for dollar for the first 3%, ½% for the next 2%) for a total of 5%.
- ★ On-site YMCA free to employee and discounted to family members
- ★ Assistance with future education:
 1. Up to \$3,000/year in employee education development
 2. National Nursing Education Initiative (NNEI) scholarship –up to \$41,572.
- ★ May qualify for the Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program
- ★ Uniform allowance provided in some nursing areas
- ★ Employee discounts to the Baltimore Aquarium, Knoebles, Lancaster Barnstormer, A&M pizza, AT&T, Verizon, Fuddruckers, and more.
- ★ Military buy back time
