

### **The VA-STEP Program**

The VA-STUDENT TRAINEE EXPERIECE PROGRAM (VA-STEP) is an honors program for select nursing students who have completed the junior year of a baccalaureate nursing program. VA-STEP provides a structured clinical experience with a BSN-prepared preceptor and educational course work in a classroom setting. The program starts with a ten-week (full-time) concentrated experience during the summer and an optional part-time experience during the senior year.

### **Program Goals**

- Learn the role of the professional nurse within a healthcare system using evidencebased practice for best patient outcomes
- Understand the culture and special needs of the Veteran population
- Develop confidence, critical thinking, and proficiency of nursing skills

# VETERANS AFFAIRS STUDENT TRAINEE EXPERIECE PROGRAM (VA-STEP) PREVIOUSLY

(VA-STEP) PREVIOUSLY VALOR

The VA-STEP nurse externship provides hands-on opportunities for outstanding nursing students to develop competencies in the clinical setting with an experienced BSN-prepared preceptor. VA-STEP Externs shadow their preceptor to learn the role of the professional nurse, while performing skills learned in nursing school. Planned didactic days offer additional learning experiences.

# VA-STEP Program Eligibility Eligible students will:

- Be currently enrolled in an accredited BSN program
- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, with no grade lower than a B in any nursing course
- Have completed the final semester/quarter of junior year prior to the program start date.
- Have had at least one clinical experience in a medical center or hospital.
- Be a U.S. Citizen.
- Provide documentation of immunization status and current Health Care Provider BLS training
- Submit all application materials by the deadline
- Not have a service obligation to any Federal, state, or private institution or be a recipient of any Federal scholarship that incurs a service obligation
- Be able to work full-time during the summer months and part-time during the academic year.

#### **BENEFITS**



- VA-STEP students are paid as hourly, intermittent employees.
- VA-STEP students are not eligible for overtime pay, holiday pay, or shift differentials. The rate of pay changes each year.
- VA-STEP students may express a preference for a unit, but they will be placed according to preceptor availability and unit needs. VA-STEP students may rotate to other units for observational experiences.
- Students in an accelerated BSN program can apply for the VA-STEP program if available to work full time from June – August of the program start year.

#### The letter should include:

- Nomination of the student to the VA-STEP Program
- Verification of enrollment as a full-time student
- Successful completion of junior year by May/June 2023
- Expected graduation within one year of entry in the VA-STEP program
