Dear Ms. Flanagan:

On June 12, 2015, by a unanimous vote, the California Coastal Commission **concurred with** the above-referenced consistency determination. Prior to the Commission hearing and vote, the Department of Veterans Affairs agreed that the following clarifications and commitments were incorporated into the project before the Commission:

The Department of Veterans Affairs agrees to submit to the Executive Director, for his review and concurrence, prior to construction:

- (1) Stormwater and water storage plans that avoid contributing to geologic instability; and
- (2) A combination of landscape screening, building setbacks, and/or stairstep designs to avoid the parking garages being visible from the Camino del Mar Trail.

The Department of Veterans Affairs also agreed that any future plans to use GGNRA parking lots would be subject to Executive Director review and concurrence.

With these commitments, the Commission found Phase 1 of the LRDP to be consistent to the maximum extent practicable with the California Coastal Management Program. If you have any questions, please feel free to call me at (415) 904-5249.
