Veteran Health Indiana will host a Veterans benefits and resource event on May 13, 2023, from 9am to 1 p.m. at the Brownsburg VA Clinic, 557 Pit Road, Brownsburg, IN 46112.

Veterans, their families, caregivers, and survivors are also invited to attend one of three briefings scheduled for 10 a.m., 11 a.m., and 12 p.m., regarding the *Promise to Address Comprehensive Toxics Act of 2022 – known as the PACT Act*. The new law expands VA health care and benefits for Veterans exposed to burn pits and other toxic substances.

Representatives will be on-site to answer questions about toxic exposure health benefits, VA eligibility & enrollment, federal and state VA benefits, filing claims, and more. Toxic exposure screening will be available. Veterans should bring a copy of their DD-214.
