- VRE ASSISTS VETERANS THROUGH SERVICES THAT CAN HELP THEM GAIN MEANINGFUL EMPLOYMENT TO BETTER CARE FOR THEMSELVES AND THEIR FAMILIES. IT MAY ALSO HELP THOSE WHO ARE UNEMPLOYABLE MAINTAIN A MORE INDEPENDENT LIFESTYLE

CHARACTER OF DISCHARGE

 VETERANS MAY BE ABLE TO QUALIFY FOR SOME VA BENEFITS WITH AN OTHER THAN HONORABLE DISCHARGE. FILE AND LET THE VA DO A CHARACTER OF DISCHARGE DETERMINATION.


