

# **HOW TO APPLY**

The RN TTP will be provided with a structured curriculum based on current CCNE Accreditation Standards under the guidance of the VHA Office of Nursing Services that includes didactic and experiential learning. The program was developed to increase the retention of newly licensed RNs and to improve the quality of patient care by providing additional training and support to the new nursing graduate.

- Open to an OKC VAHCS employee in their first RN role.
- US Citizen by birth or naturalization
- Graduated from an AACN or CCNE accredited nursing program (BSN or ADN)
- Hold a current, full and unrestricted license as a RN
- Fluent in written and spoken English
