


# Fall 2023 Newsletter

### Fall is here - It's time to get your flu shot!

Boise VA offers flu shots for enrolled Veterans at our Primary Care Clinics and Community Based Outpatient Clinics (CBOC), or our October flu clinics:



**Vaccinated Outside VA:** You can get vaccinated from a contracted community provider. Visit <u>www.prevention.va.gov/flu</u> to check eligibility and locate a provider. Bring your VA ID card. For eligible Veterans there is no copay. **\*Please let your Primary Care team know the specific date of your vaccine.**

### Important My HealtheVet Changes Coming December 1, 2023

The way you login to My HealtheVet is changing December 1st. Log on from one of two sites:

 ID.me

You will lose access to My HealtheVet starting December 1, 2023. This login is more secure and reduces your risk of identity theft. Update your login information to keep your access!

## Your Preventative Health Reminders

#### Vaccines

- Have you gotten your COVID Booster?
- 2-dose **Shingles vaccines** due for ages 50+ & 2nd dose is 2-6 months later

#### \*Received a vaccine elsewhere?

Update your record by sending a copy to your Primary Care team. You can also use the Annie App as a tool.



Screenings: Look before you have symptoms:

- Colon cancer screening starts at age 45.
- Blood pressure screenings every year.
- Breast cancer screening for women every year ages 45-54.
- Cervical cancer screening every 3 years ages 21-29 and ages 30-65 every 3-5 years.
