Please read these instructions carefully and follow them all for a successful procedure

10 days before your procedure

Call your primary care physician to find out how to take any diabetic, or blood thinning medications before your procedure

Diabetic Medications include oral and or insulin.

Blood Thinners inlcude, but are not limited to warfarin (Coumadin), Clopidogrel (Plavix), enoxaparin (Lovenox), prasugrel (Effient), brilinta (Ticagrelor), pradaxa (Dabigatran), xarelto (Rivaroxaban), eliquis (Apixaban)

Continue to take your prescribed Aspirin

1 day before procedure instructions

- 1. You may eat your regular meals
- 2. Take all your medications, except for the adjustments in diabetic and blood thinning medicines made by your Primary Care physician.
- 3. No food after Midnight

Day of procedure

- 1. Do not eat or drink.
- 2. Take all your medications, except for the adjustments in diabetic and blood thinning medicines made by your Primary Care physician, with sips of water by 6am.
