

INTERNSHIP APPLICATIONS

APPLICATION DEADLINE – WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 1, 2023

ELIGIBILITY

- U.S. Citizenship
- Minimum 350 intervention hours plus 75 assessment practicum hours
- Doctoral student in good standing at an American Psychological Association (APA) or Canadian Psychological Association (CPA) accredited graduate program in Clinical, Counseling, or Combined psychology or Psychological Clinical Science Accreditation System (PCSAS) accredited program in Clinical Science. Persons with a doctorate in another area of psychology who meet the APA or CPA criteria for respecialization training in Clinical, Counseling, or Combined Psychology are also eligible.
- Approved for internship status by graduate program training director.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. AAPI ONLINE APPLICATION (available at APPIC Web Site: <http://www.appic.org/>)
2. 3-4 LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

We are primarily concerned with your clinical skills and abilities. We recommend that you submit only 1 letter from a professor who knows you only from your course work or research. The remaining letters should come from clinical supervisors.

3. COVER LETTER

Please be sure to note the following in your cover letter:

- The track to which you are applying – General or Neuropsychology
- The rotations of interest to you

4. PERSONAL INTERVIEW BY INVITATION

Interviews will be conducted in January. All interviews will be via videoconference. Notifications for January interviews will be emailed by December 15, 2023.
