


This local non-profit works with Fisher House Foundation to support the Albuquerque Fisher House by fundraising.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR FISHER HOUSE FAMILIES**

- ✓ Live 50 miles or more from the NMVA
- Family member of an Active Duty Service Member or an inpatient Veteran at the NMVA
- ✓ Actively engaged, needed for bedside support
- ✓ Medically stable, not under a doctor's care
- ✓ Independent and able to live in a shared home.
- ✓ Living in permanent, stable housing (not homeless)
- ✓ Is free from communicable illness (flu, chicken pox, etc.)
- ✓ Abides by the Guest Agreements and Rules

# The Albuquerque Fisher House will be celebrating our 4th Anniversary on October 19, 2023

Fisher House Foundation donated the Albuquerque Fisher House to the New Mexico VA on October 19, 2019.

We are the 85th Fisher House constructed and donated by the Foundation: there are now 95 Fisher Houses across the world serving Veterans and Active Duty families.

Families who meet eligibility criteria are able to stay close to their hospitalized loved one at no charge.
